The Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) Building Fund provides capital grants to eligible community capital projects for the creation of new child care spaces through new <u>non-profit</u> child care centre development, or expansions projects of existing <u>non-profit</u> child care centres. The minimum size of capital development should be 52 spaces for infant and/or pre-school and school-age children in urban centres, and 24 spaces in rural Manitoba. The ELCC program also offers the Child Care Centre Development Tax Credit (CCCDTC) Program. This program provides a tax credit for private taxable corporations who invest in the creation of new ELCC spaces to support their employees and the surrounding community.
