This circular is to inform you that Child Care Coordinators will be completing relicensing inspections over the next number of months for all ELCC facilities, beginning in April 2022.

Due to the disruption of the pandemic and staffing changes over the past two years, Child Care Coordinators may conduct more than one visit (announced and unannounced) to complete the licensing inspection checklist.

Please ensure that all documentation, training and postings required under <u>The Community Child Care Standards Act</u> and <u>Child Care Regulation 62/86</u> are complete and up-to-date, including information that is entered on Child Care Online.

We appreciate your cooperation, patience and understanding during this transition time.
