Eligibility Requirements

In order for Trades Qualifiers (TQ) to be approved to challenge the certification exam or for Designated Trainers (DT) to be approved to register apprentices, you must have worked both a minimum of 1.5 years within the last 10 and accumulated 2,700 hours, as well as acquired at least 70% scope of the trade.

Note: A Certificate of Qualification in the trade of Machinist or the trade of Tool and Die Maker is required to apply.
