Class "A" Fairs	
PROVINCIAL EXHIBITION ASSOCIATION, BRANDON	Improvements to horse jumps, trailers, computer equipment, greenery, new ag awareness displays
RED RIVER EXHIBITION, WINNIPEG	Build information booth; repairs electrical upgrades; ventilation system in main building; Repaint main building; Build large sign holders and banner boxes for parking lot; New benches;

Class "B" Fairs	
<u>DAUPHIN</u>	Repair barns including stalls and wiring; Repair and upgrade show ring; Granular material for grounds; repair announcer booths, including paint, floors and skids; signage for grounds;
<u>DUFFERIN</u>	New wiring and changing electrical panels in food booths and hot water tank. Paint barns; electrical upgrades on exhibit building (outside electrical) 3 – 4 new freezers; panels for corral
<u>PORTAGE LA PRAIRIE</u>	Sound system in exhibition building; replace fence around horse ring with steel panels or pipe, add sand to horse ring; put mud in 4-H barn and fill in the campground; seal and paint heritage building, landscaping grounds re: trees, rock placement, cement work, electric upgrade at Ex. Building
<u>SWAN RIVER</u>	Remove and rebuild security/safety fence on exhibition grounds. Cost estimate; Pending funding of grant applied for to MB Services Council. Strapping metal on bathrooms; Painting office; Repairs; Gravel

Class “B” Fairs	
<u>VALLEY (Morris)</u>	Replacer picnic tables with new steel framed tables (10/year); Rebuild last 3 (frontline) electrical panels; paint and repair show ring bleachers; Misc. Equipment repairs; replace and reinforce wood on race track rail. Security booth repairs, heavy horse barn stall repairs; general grounds maintenance and repair;
<u>VIRDEN</u>	Turn old washrooms into handicap accessible; turn one of unused barns into a permanent life style section; put siding on two of the barn doors; run electricity to our judges stand; two new signs.

Class “C” Fairs	
<u>ARBORG</u>	Refurbish outdoor stage and bleachers, stage needs floor and some joists replaced and painted. Bleachers require renewal to accommodate handrails and new steps to make safe and “age friendly”
<u>BEAUTIFUL PLAINS (Neepawa)</u>	Repairs to indoor riding arena by installing puckboard along walls. Repair structural damage; Requesting funding for assistance in wages for installation of puckboard as purchased board a few years back and have never installed. Repair structural damage; Wages for installation;
<u>BIRTLE</u>	Repair ticket booth; improve fencing around light horse ring
<u>BROKENHEAD (Beausejour)</u>	Purchase new livestock panels to expand rodeo and fair facility use. These panels will also be used for upcoming 2012 Centennial celebration. Ag society has been approached to host RCMP musical ride. We used last year's grant to purchase first 4 sets of panels and gates and this year we plan on purchasing 16 – 10'panels and next's years requested will be for additional 16 panels and gates.
<u>CARBERRY</u>	Major upgrades to the grandstand.

Class “C” Fairs	
<u>CRYSTAL CITY</u>	Purchase laptop; paint & repair bleachers, partitions, lease tractor for waste removal & equipment set up
<u>CYPRESS RIVER</u>	Pump House repairs – roof, fascia, and soffit.
<u>DELORAINE</u>	Painting, strengthen south end rail around race track
<u>ELKHORN</u>	Build 18 x 32 pole shed; tin buildings; paint for inside buildings; general supplies
<u>FOXWARREN</u>	Replace 2 nd steel door; add wood shavings for top cover on cement floor (2 truckloads)
<u>GILBERT PLAINS</u>	Supply and install chain link fencing around new ball diamond.
<u>GLADSTONE</u>	Purchase laptop computer and software to use for fair entries, etc.
<u>GLENBORO</u>	New piping (pex lines) upgrade bathrooms (changing toilets) painting; purchase water pump.
<u>HAMIOTA</u>	New roofing on existing barns, metal siding on display building; repairs to interiors of existing barns; necessity to keep High school Rodeo Provincials.
<u>HANOVER (Grunthal)</u>	Ground work, steel posts, penning, panels for second riding/dhow arena.
<u>HARDING</u>	Roofing for more stalls for heavy horses and minis
<u>HOLLAND</u>	Continue project started in 2010 to replace multi-purpose building using existing cement and replace with 30’x40’; Did new drainage ditch for new approach and culvert; repair sound system; replace new environmentally friendly shower heads; 6L toilets;
<u>KELWOOD</u>	Re-tin cattle facilities; replace roof/poles; breaker boxes need replacement.
<u>KILLARNEY</u>	Purchase laser tag system for entertainment; revamping homecraft area – redone tables and are replacing signs with coroplast displays, New street gates for racetrack and heavy horse ring.
<u>LUNDAR</u>	Purchase computer and printer for fair entries, judges books, etc.; Purchase 8 – 10 food panels for show ring and public safety; repair horse barn door and roof;

Class “C” Fairs	
<u>MANITOU</u>	Shingle/tin horse stall roof, paint and repair horse stalls, upkeep horse ring with 3 loads of sand, paint announcers booth and maintenance on bleachers.
<u>McCREARY</u>	Must upgrade bathrooms and lease additional portapotties; sand and gravel for a drainage cleanout ditch; office repair upgrade, fencing for safety and security; bleacher upkeep – new planks where needed; supplies for new signage. (Centennial Year)
<u>MIAMI</u>	Repair and paint grandstand; repair office building window; update stove in kitchen; replace 2 toilets;
<u>MINNEDOSA</u>	Install hydro and water into new facilities
<u>OAK LAKE</u>	Apply tin to exterior of food booth on fairgrounds. Purchase additional upright cooler; purchase steel panels to repair rodeo arena.
<u>OAK RIVER</u>	New paint for men’s washroom; Trenching to repair water line to wash racks and barns; barn repairs.
<u>OPASQUIA</u>	Purchase small tractor needed for cutting grass, working up riding arena.
<u>PELICAN LAKE/ NINETTE</u>	Set up website; purchase bleachers, replace or fix announcers stands, purchase picnic tables and benches
<u>PIPESTONE-ALBERT (Reston)</u>	Finish building project of tinning the body of grandstand.
<u>PLUMAS/LANSDOWNE</u>	Cover open sided barn to house animals at fair as no longer safe; original planking, 30 plus years of age is rotten and needs replacement. There are 16 stalls, 9’ x 9’. New planking will be 2’ x 10’ in 18’ lengths for strength and little waste. Facility used for fair plus 4-H beef club. .
<u>RAPID CITY</u>	Repair and maintenance to existing buildings; painting and repair or replacement of windows and doors; replace and repair fencing
<u>RIVERS</u>	Repair to men’s washrooms; replace all pressed board inside washroom; outside of entire washrooms tinned and inside of kitchen

Class "C" Fairs	
<u>ROBLIN</u>	Repair show ring railing stalls, walls on both south and west barns, sound booth and show office. Repair or replace show office door; Purchase posts, rails, panel boards, lumber, nails, screws and paint.
<u>ROCKWOOD (Stonewall)</u>	Building requires a new HRV unit to bring fresh air into building as required by code.
<u>ROLAND</u>	New wind shelter for west rink door to replace damaged existing shelter; Igloo#4101, 10 gal. Cold drink thermoses; Westbend #33600, 100 cup coffee perks to increase existing equipment; #4901 rubbermaid food cart for moving food trays
<u>SHOAL LAKE</u>	Replace rotting plywood roof on one pole shed. Reface end with metal. Need roof structure of wood covered by metal panels. Locate and repair hold in water line for washing station.
<u>SOURIS/GLENWOOD</u>	Repair the north side of the canteen booth due to a break in. Install new window; repair inside ceiling as per food inspector (ie to hide the pink insulation on the edges of the ceiling).
<u>SPRINGFIELD (Dugald)</u>	Replace 80 year old fence with a 6 foot commercial chain link fence. Remove a run down wooden fence on yard with a four foot chain link fence. Cost of 6' fence; 4' fence; Site preparation.
<u>ST. ANDREWS/ ST. CLEMENTS (Selkirk)</u>	Repairs to outdoor barns and continue with replacement of grand stand seating. Paint as required to building and fence.
<u>ST. VITAL</u>	Purchase software for updating fair program; speakers for presentations; replace 10 resin tables; replace 25 resin chairs
<u>STANLEY (Winkler)</u>	Build 8 new display tables with cages for our exhibition
<u>STRATHCLAIR</u>	Build new bleachers made of steel and canvas awnings; repair awnings on other 3 bleachers with new canvas.
<u>TREHERNE</u>	Purchase new freezer to replace very old ones that is energy efficient; purchase 8 sheets of poly carbonate to cover windows; paint for windows; scrape & paint windows; gable ends on 4-H barn paint food booth exterior and interior of serving areas; put sealant around poly carbonate installed over windows.

Class "C" Fairs	
<u>TURTLE MOUNTAIN</u> <u>(Boissevain)</u>	Rebuild west horse sand ring with new posts and oil drill stem piping, Start phase 1 of display building upgrades by replacing old wooden tables with new folding ones down centre of display building.
<u>WAWANESA</u>	Repair and paint barns #2 & 3; repair stalls in #2 as well as exterior painting on both barns.
