



Environmental Farm Plan Workshops



The Environmental Farm Plan Program helps Manitoba farmers develop environmental action plans and adopt beneficial management practices (BMPs) that support a cleaner, healthier environment and increase agricultural sustainability. It's voluntary and completely confidential.

Manitoba Agriculture, Food and Rural Initiatives (MAFRI) is conducting free environmental farm plan (EFP) workshops across rural Manitoba.

Register for these two, half-day workshops and you will be guided through an EFP workbook to help you identify the environmental assets and risks of your operation. Workbooks and support material will be provided to producers who attend the workshops.

To preregister for each half-day session, contact the MAFRI GO Office listed.

If there are no upcoming dates in your location, an EFP workshop can be scheduled in your area. Contact your local MAFRI GO Office for complete details.

Applying for Financial Incentives

To apply for financial incentives, environmental farm plans must be renewed every five years to remain valid. Check the date of your Statement of Completion to ensure you are eligible to apply for the Environmental Farm Action Program.
