MANITOBA AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS TO THE UNITED STATES

- Manitoba agri-food exports to the U.S. were \$2,430.4 million in 2008, up 21.1% from 2007 levels. Manitoba's agri-food exports to all destinations were \$4,735.7 million in 2008, up 27.0% from the previous year.
- The U.S. accounted for 51.3% of Manitoba's total agri-food exports in 2008, down slightly from 53.8% in 2007, with 28.0% of all unprocessed goods, 90.3% of all semi-processed goods and 52.3% of all processed goods.
- Combined hog and pork exports to the U.S. in 2008 totaled \$344.3 million, down 29.0% from 2007 and 30.2% from 2006. Hog and pork exports to the U.S. in 2008 accounted for virtually all hogs and 16.5% of total pork exports to all destinations.

Unprocessed/Bulk:

- 2008 unprocessed or bulk exports increased 54.3% from 2007 levels to account for 28.6% of Manitoba's total exports to the U.S. Bulk exports, primarily field crops, were valued at \$696.2 million.
- In 2008, bulk oat exports totaled \$199.0 million, an increase of 43.3% from 2007 and the value of bulk wheat exports was \$148.6 million, up 125.5% from the previous year.
- In 2008, Manitoba exported \$111.3 million in bulk canola to the U.S., up 104.2% from 2007 levels.

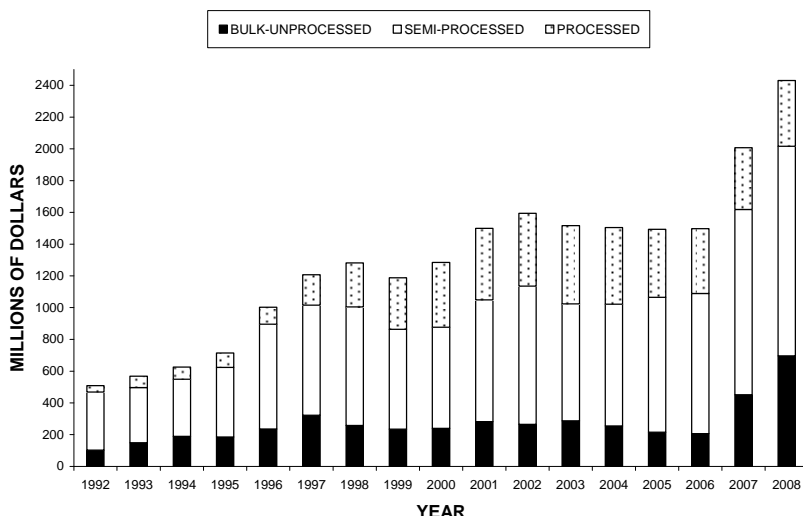
Semi-Processed/Intermediate:

- Semi-processed exports accounted for 54.3% of the total exported to the U.S. and were primarily products from hogs, beef, canola oil and meal, pulse crops and oat groats, meal and flakes. Exports were a record \$1,320.2 million, 13.1% more than in 2007.
- Canola oil exports to the U.S.A. were \$459.3 million with meal exports of \$81.2 million, a combined increase of 71.3% over 2007. That represented virtually all of Manitoba's total canola oil and meal exports.
- Manitoba's live cattle and bison exports were all attributed to direct U.S. shipments. In 2008, the total value of exports increased 9.4% from a year earlier to \$306.4 million.
- Exports of hogs to the U.S. were valued at \$278.0 million in 2008, down 31.4% from 2007. Virtually all of Manitoba's hogs were exported to the U.S..

Processed/Consumer:

- Processed exports accounted for 17.0% of Manitoba's total exports to the U.S. and were primarily potato products and pork. Processed exports to the U.S. totaled \$414.0 million in 2008, 6.5% more than in 2007.
- 16.5% of Manitoba's processed pork and all processed beef exports go to the U.S. Processed pork exports to the U.S. totaled \$66.3 million in 2008, down 17.3% from 2007, processed beef exports totaled \$100 thousand.
- Processed potato exports to the U.S. totaled a record \$276.7 million in 2008, an increase of 12.3% over 2007 levels. The U.S. accounts for 94.1% of Manitoba's total processed potato exports to all destinations.
