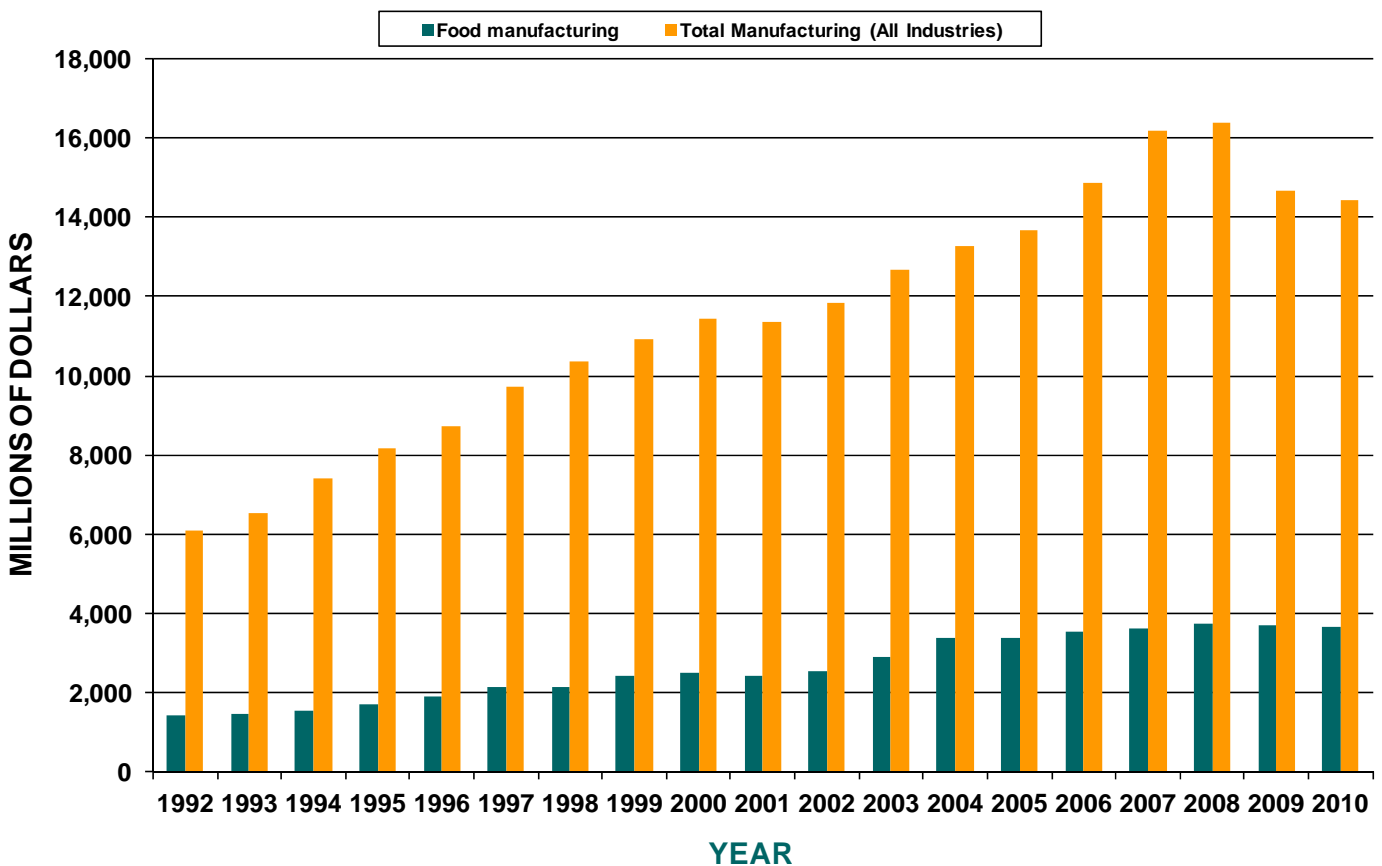

MANITOBA FOOD MANUFACTURING SALES

Manitoba's food and beverage industry is a major contributor to the provincial economy. Food and beverage processing is the largest manufacturing sector, with \$3.7 billion in sales in 2010. This represents 25% of total manufacturing output in Manitoba, given that the value of all goods manufactured in Manitoba totalled \$14.4 billion in 2010.

Manitoba's share of national manufacturing is 2.7% and the province produces 4.1% of the nation's food and beverage processing. In 2010, Canadian manufacturing firms generated \$530 billion in sales, an increase of 8.9% from the previous year. Nationally, food and beverage processing industries represent the largest manufacturing sector at \$91.2 billion or 17.2%.

With over 250 companies in Manitoba's value-added food processing industry, the sector accounts for 3.4% of provincial GDP at market prices or \$1.63 billion. This provides 23,600 jobs or 4% of Manitoba's total employment. Labour income attributable to the food processing industry in Manitoba is estimated at \$816 million or 3.5% of the province's total labour income.
