

**LETTER OF INTENT
BETWEEN
MANITOBA EDUCATION, TRAINING AND YOUTH
AND
THE CANADIAN FOUNDATION CENTER FOR INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION**

In a spirit of mutual cooperation, and in order to enhance understanding and friendship between Manitoba and China, representatives of the two parties named above have engaged in preliminary discussions regarding the development and establishment of a Manitoba high school program in Guangxi Province, China.

It is understood that further discussions are needed in order to determine whether such a program would be feasible and mutually beneficial to both parties. These discussions will occur over the next few months and, if they prove fruitful, may lead to a more formal agreement.

Manitoba Education, Training and Youth is pleased to have the opportunity to enter into discussions with the Canadian Foundation Center for International Education to explore the establishment of a Manitoba high school program in Guangxi Province, China.
