

**LETTER OF INTENT
BETWEEN
XIAMEN NO. 3 MIDDLE SCHOOL, China
AND
MANITOBA EDUCATION, CITIZENSHIP AND YOUTH, Canada**

In a spirit of mutual cooperation, and in order to work together to enhance understanding and friendship between Manitoba and China, representatives of the two parties named above have engaged in a series of discussions regarding the development and establishment of a Manitoba high school program in Xiamen, China.

Xiamen No. 3 Middle School is interested in offering students the option of obtaining both a Manitoba and a Chinese high school diploma through a blended curricula program. The school would like to begin offering this program by Spring 2005.

During the next several weeks, MECY and the school will continue discussions on the necessary preparations for mounting a blended program in China. An inspection visit in early November by a representative of MECY is also being considered. If the conditions of the school are satisfactory, MECY and the Xiamen Middle School No. 3 may negotiate a formal agreement authorizing the school to use the Manitoba curriculum.

The two parties look forward to continuing their discussions on the establishment of a Manitoba high school program in Xiamen, China.
