



HSC WINNIPEG CAMPUS MASTER PLAN

The capital master plan for the HSC Winnipeg campus will be aligned with *Manitoba's Clinical* and *Preventive Services Plan* and build on recent capital projects at the campus that reflect HSC Winnipeg's importance in Manitoba's health system as the provincial tertiary centre for trauma, transplants, burns, neurosciences, complex cancer care and pediatrics.

These projects include the:

- HSC Women's Hospital, which opened in December 2019, providing inpatient and outpatient obstetrical, surgical and medical services to women and families;
- Diagnostic Centre of Excellence, which enhances patient access to a variety of expert imaging and diagnostic tools, including a pediatric cardiac catheterization lab and interventional radiology suites;
- Wilf Taillieu Thoracic Surgery and Endoscopy Unit, funded by donors to HSC Foundation, which diverts procedures from operating rooms and speeds time to diagnosis and treatment;
- Low acuity area of adult emergency, streaming 30 to 50 patients out of the main department to better manage patient flow and reduce overall wait times;
- relocated and expanded eight-bed intermediate intensive care unit;
- former Ellen Douglass School on Elgin Avenue, which will consolidate medicine clinics in a single facility, thus freeing up key space for acute activities;
- enhanced plastic surgery clinic and procedure rooms, funded by HSC Foundation, which decant procedures from both the emergency department and the main operating rooms;
- first hospital-based helipad in the province, allowing for the reduction of transport times for critically ill or injured patients and providing them direct access to emergency rooms and operating theatres upon arrival; and
- new dedicated acute stroke unit, which will prevent stroke complications and recurrence for patients when it opens, speeding up their recovery time and ensuring early rehabilitation therapy.
