THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

BOSSHILL CREEK (PENNER) PROJECT

The applicant shall comply with the following limits, terms and conditions for the modification and management of Bosshill Creek to create a 11.76 hectare marsh suitable for waterfowl production located in the Rural Municipality of Wallace on east-half of Section 23, Township 11, Range 28 W1, and the west-half of Section 24, Township 11, Range 28 W1, in accordance with the information filed within the Environment Act Proposal Form dated May 31, 1988:

- (1). Construction shall not proceed until the proponent has provided written evidence to the Director that a Licence has been obtained pursuant to the Water Rights Act from the Water Resources Branch, Manitoba Department of Natural Resources or the requirements of the Water Rights Act have been satisfactorily met should such a licence not be required.
- (2). All earthworks shall be stabilized in order to prevent soil erosion, with the use of rock or concrete armour, planting of artificial mixtures of plants, natural re-vegetation, and other appropriate measures as indicated in the Environment Act Proposal Form and attachments dated May 31, 1989.
- (3). Refuse piles consisting of domestic or agricultural wastes such as metal, containers, manure or other materials shall be re-located above the Full Supply Level.
