
In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

GREINA CONSUMERS CO-OP LTD.; APPLICANT

The following limits, terms and conditions shall be complied with in conjunction with the operation of a smokehouse located on Lots 22/24 of Block 5 of Plan 28 M.L.T.O. in the Village of Gretna, Manitoba:

1. The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emissions from any process of the operation do not at any time exceed 0.23 grams per standard cubic metre, calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury at the point of emission.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that visible smoke emissions from the operation do not exhibit an opacity in excess of:
 - a) 20 percent for a period exceeding 4 minutes in the aggregate in any one hour;
 - b) 40 percent at any time at the point of emission.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that the emissions of odour from the operation are not detectable at any point of impingement beyond the property line in a residential area when one volume of odorous air is diluted with one volume of odour-free air.
4. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times consistent with meeting the requirements of Clauses 1, 2 and 3 of this Licence.
5. The Applicant shall not, at any time, dispose of garbage or refuse by burning on the site of the operation.
