The Rural Municipality of Mossey River and the Rural Municipality of Lawrence: "the Licencee"

for the construction and maintenance of the Development being a project to minimize flooding and improve drainage on a tract of land along the west boundary of the R.M. of Mossey River and along the east boundary of the R. M. of Lawrence, subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the design specifications outlined in File No. 82-8-1004, Sheets 1 through 8 dated 91/10/04 and File No. 82-5-1005 Sheets 1 through 3 dated 91/10/03, all prepared by Manitoba Water Resources.
- 2) The Licencee shall construct rock drop structures as shown in the plans described in Clause 1) of this Licence, using material of sufficient size to withstand water velocities up to the 20% flow frequency event.
- 3) The Licencee shall slope ditch spoil material to a minimum slope of 8 horizontal to 1 vertical and seed the material during the same year of construction.
- 4) The Licencee shall not undertake construction activities between April 1 and June 30 of any year. Winter construction activities shall be limited to brush clearing.
- 5) The Licencee shall not construct tributary drains on the following Crown lands:
 - NE 1 and SE 12-30-17W
 - All of 36-29-17W
 - SE 25-29-17W
 - E 24-29-17W
 - SW 31-29-16W
 - All of 30-29-16W
 - All of 19-29-16W
- 6) The Licencee shall reseed disturbed areas of natural vegetation with a mixture of native or introduced grasses.
- 7) The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction and maintenance of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
