AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE MANITOBA WATER SERVICES BOARD;

IN THE MATTER OF: Order No. 941, Issued by The Clean Environment Commission to the Rural Municipality of Brokenhead (attached as Appendix "A");

WHEREAS after giving notice of its intention to deal with a proposal submitted pursuant to Section 14(1) of The Clean Environment Act, and after advising the Municipality's consultant and the said Board of the limits, terms and conditions recommended by the department for inclusion in an order of the Commission, and after not receiving a notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected by such an order, the Commission issued Order No. 941 to the Municipality on the 25th day of February, 1982, pursuant to Section 15(1) of the said Act, in connection with a sewage lagoon system serving the unincorporated village of Tyndall, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS no appeal from the said order was filed with the Minister pursuant to Section 17(1) of the said Act;

AND WHEREAS on the 14th day of February, 1983, the Board submitted to the Commission a request for variation of the said order, pursuant to Section 14(7) of the said Act, by the deletion of Clause 7 of the order;

AND WHEREAS after giving notice, the Commission held a hearing in Winnipeg on the 8th day of June, 1983, to receive evidence and representations concerning the request for variation of the said order;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the request for variation on the 20th day of June, 1983;
