**Re: Brady Road Resource Management Facility (landfill)-  
Environment Act Licence No. 3081 R - Notice of Alteration Approval**

Thank you for your notice of alteration dated November 8, 2023, seeking approval to construct a deep-pit burial for pig mortalities at the landfill. You propose to conduct a pilot study to determine the time to decompose pig mortalities in the deep pit and schedule A of this approval identifies its location.

I approve the alteration per section 14(2) of The Environment Act. This approval expires on March 31, 2028.

In executing the work, the licensee must:

1. notify the environment officer at least five days before placement of the mortalities;
2. not compost any diseased animal;
3. if mortalities are held for longer than 24 hours, store onsite before using them for composting:
  - a) in a secure storage room, covered container, or secure location; and
  - b) in a refrigerated or frozen state.
4. dispose of any mortalities in excess of the amount approved by this notice alteration following the licence;
5. notify an environment officer within 24 hours of receipt of any odour complaints associated with the pilot project;
6. on or before February 28 of each year and starting from the second year of operation, submit an annual monitoring report to the director. The report must include the visual monitoring data, analysis and discussion of the data, conclusion, and next steps of the study;
7. not remove material resulting from the pilot study from the landfill;

8. submit a final report of the study to the director by February 29, 2028; and
9. submit an approval extension request by February 29, 2028, if needed.

All other clauses of Environment Act Licence No. 3081 R remain in effect. This approval is available on the public registry at <https://www.gov.mb.ca/sd/eal/registries/index.html>.
