Hi Elise,

Fisheries Branch has reviewed this proposal to build a new 115-24kV Station on Madison Ave. This will require lines to be tied in from the current St. James Station. There are no surface waters within the proposed work area. Assiniboine River is 0.5 km south of the St. James Station. It would appear that there are minimal concerns with this proposal except for the potential of a spill which could lead to runoff to storm water drains. Manitoba Hydro however has indicated that the final design of the facility will be subject to containment assessment procedures. During construction, particularly re-routing the lines, they should implement sediment control measures to minimize sediment entering stormwater drains.

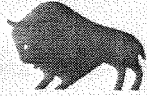
