FACILITY UPGRADES IN VIRDEN, MANITOBA**

Dear Ms. Braun:

On behalf of the Town of Virden, please find enclosed five hard copies and one electronic copy of the Environment Act Proposal for the Town of Virden Waste Water Treatment Facility in Virden, Manitoba. Also enclosed is a signed EAP form; as well the Manitoba Water Services Board has forwarded a \$5,000 check for the application fee that should arrive separately at your offices January 9th, 2014.

This application proposes a new primary and secondary treatment process with UV disinfection to completely replace the existing sewage treatment process. The existing building will be maintained for laboratory and operator office as well as re-using the existing process area for the sludge digestion process. Due to funding constraints, the project will be phased in construction with Phase I starting in 2014 being a new headworks building with primary treatment and disinfection. The staging details as well as the anticipated schedule are presented in the application.
