Camping Rates

Camping rates are based on services provided:

• basic service	\$10.50 - \$18.90
• electrical service	\$14.70 - \$23.10
• electrical/water service	\$17.85 - \$24.15
• full service	\$19.95 - \$26.25
• group	\$31.50 - \$201.60
• cabins	\$34.41 - \$78.44
• yurts	\$51.52

Fees may lower depending on available services.

Vehicle Park Entry Permits

Park vehicle permits must be displayed year-round in provincial parks. Permits are available at all campground and district offices, and most business locations that sell fishing and hunting licences.
