**B**urge Lake is a small, scenic campground with eight basic walk-up, trailer sites. All sites are suitable for tents, trailers and some can accommodate large motor homes. There are no camping fees. Service includes: pit privy bathrooms, complimentary firewood, a hand water pump and a group-use picnic shelter which is ideal for family reunions or friendly get-togethers.

The campground is just minutes away from the clear, clean waters of Burge Lake. Relax on the beautiful, sandy beach while the children enjoy the playground. Anglers will appreciate the

convenience of a fish cleaning shed, dock and boat launch. The lake offers swimming, boating and excellent walleye and northern pike fishing. Peaceful and uncrowded, it is a great getaway for the whole family.

Burge Lake Campground is located approximately 10 kilometers from the town of Lynn Lake off of Provincial Truck Highway 394.

### Campground Tips

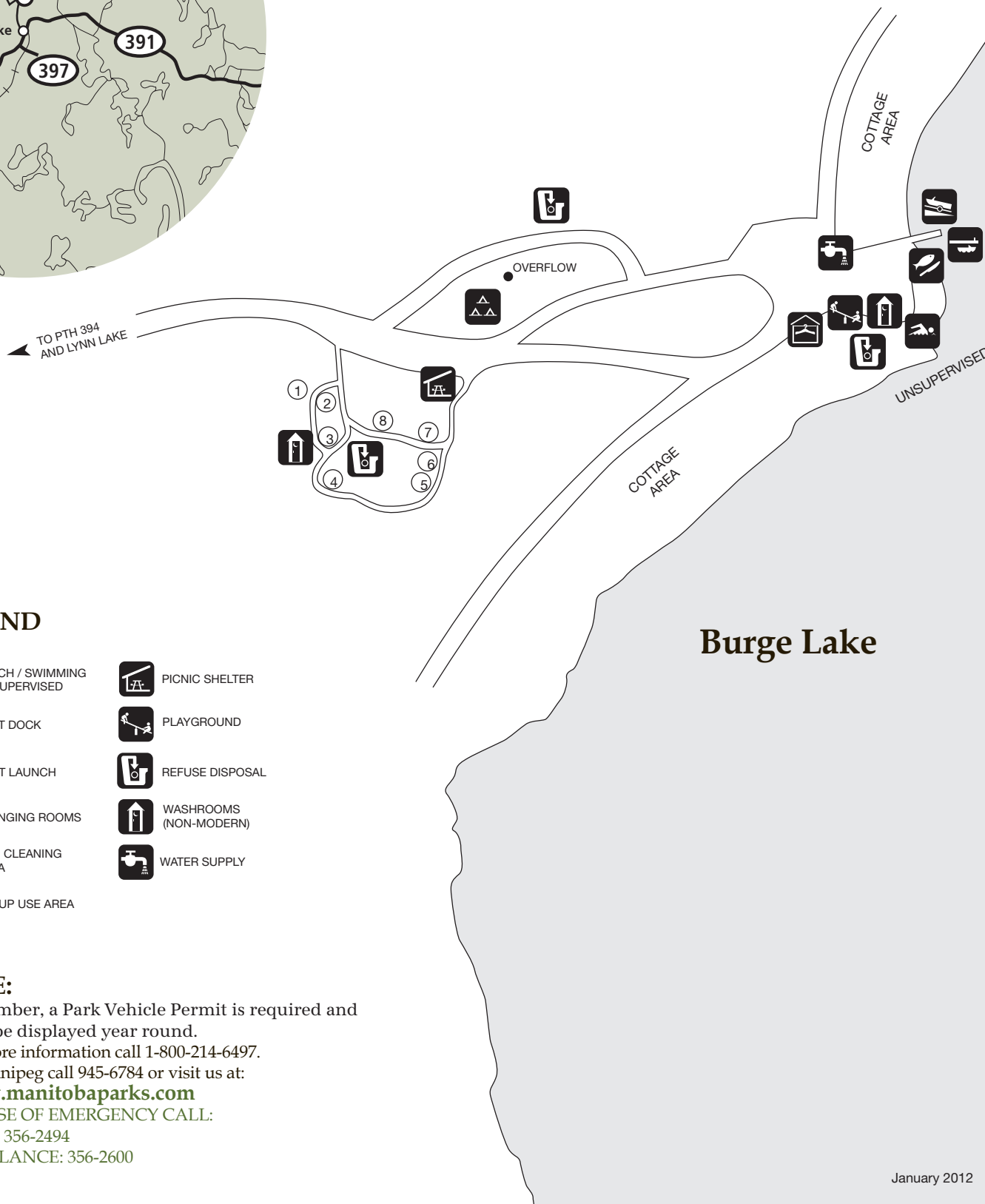
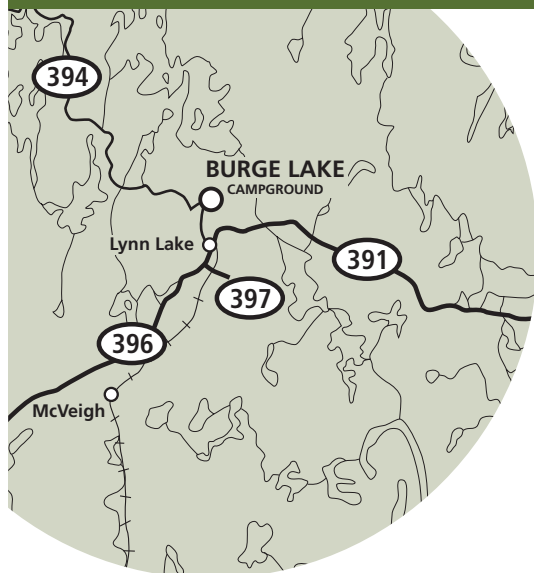
- Be sure matches are extinguished. Break them in half before discarding.
- Build no fires except in a designated firepit or use a camp stove. Before leaving make sure your fire is completely out.
- Be careful with your cigarettes, cigars and pipe ashes. Crush them thoroughly before discarding. Never toss them from a vehicle.

Please! Do not litter.

- Be sensitive to wildlife. Bears can be dangerous and should not be fed. Food must be stored away from your campsite, preferably in a locked vehicle, to avoid attracting hungry animals. Do not store food in your tent.
- Warm clothing is needed for cool nights.
- The use of insect repellent will add to your comfort.
- In case of injury or illness contact a Campground Attendant or Park Patrol Officer. They can assist you to reach medical help.
- Canoeists and hikers travelling in backcountry areas should advise a friend of their intended destination and anticipated length of trip.
- Backcountry camping is only allowed at designated campsites.
- It is illegal to use or transport elm firewood.
