EPR PRAIRIE PROCESS



- ◆ Establish broad stakeholder group.
- ◆ Involve stakeholders early.
- ◆ Identify regulated alternative if no voluntary action taken.
- ◆ Establish working committees to resolve issues.
- ◆ Provide strong leadership in consultative process from the start.
- ◆ Establish inter-provincial coordinating body (WCTF).

“Consensus Support Is A Must For Success”

EPR PRAIRIE PRIORITIES

- ◆ Ensure stakeholders have a shared vision of the task.
- ◆ Test government's willingness to provide tough supporting legislation/regulations.
- ◆ Gain early support of key stakeholders.
- ◆ Involve recycling community in the process from the start.
- ◆ Pilot test new ideas prior to implementation.
- ◆ Make program registration mandatory with serious penalties for non-compliance.

EPR PRAIRIE PITFALLS (POTENTIAL)



- ◆ Exclusion of difficult stakeholders.
- ◆ Overly optimistic process timing expectations.
- ◆ Inaccurate modeling of sales/collections/costs.
- ◆ Lack of understanding government priorities versus industry priorities.
- ◆ Overestimating direct management support available from stakeholders.
- ◆ Unrealistic evaluation of recycling industry's ability to manage increased volumes.

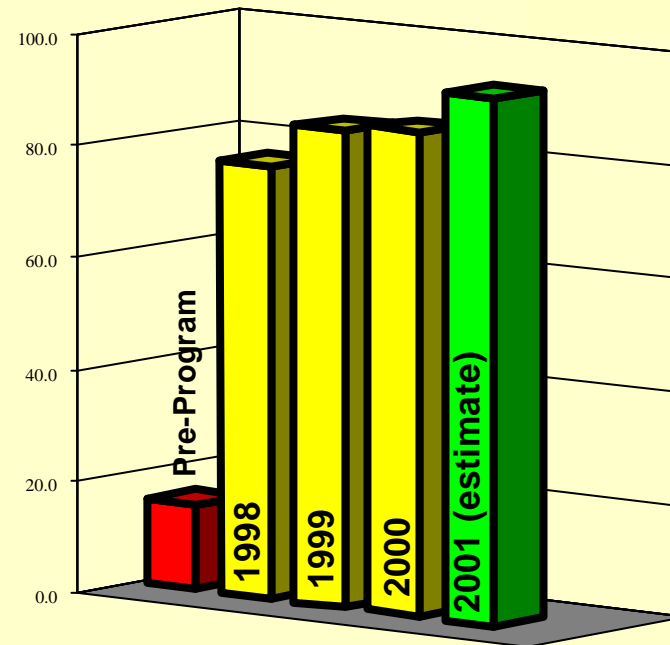

Oil Recycled *millions of litres*



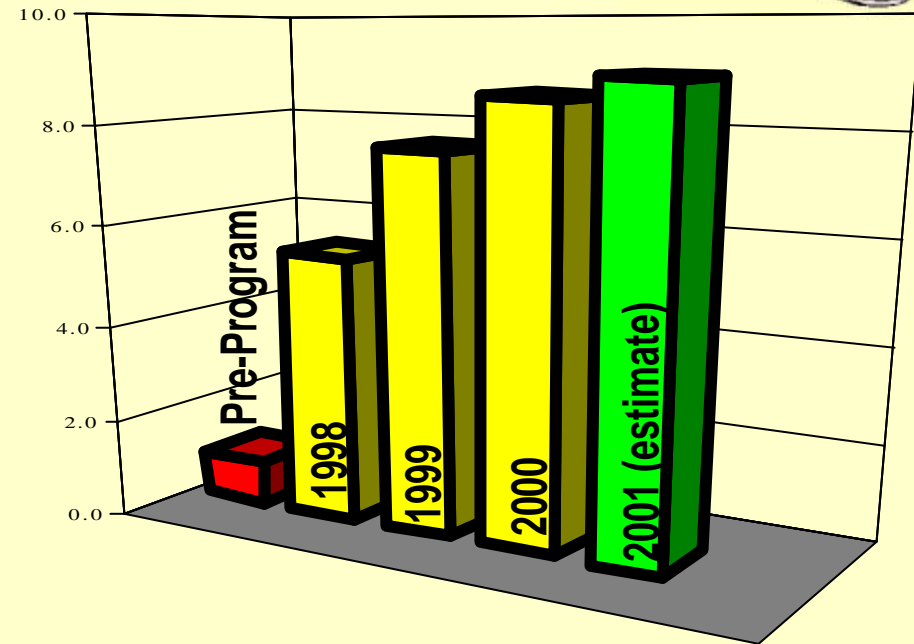
2002/03 – Maintain steady growth in collections through enhanced public education and outreach programs.

Oil Filters – Program has reached maturity (80% recovery).

Filters Recycled *millions*



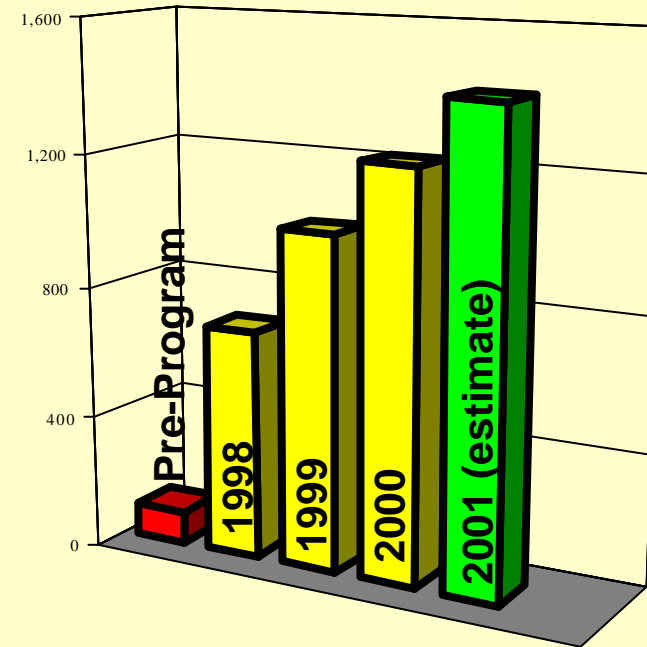
2002/03 – Expand new weight based collection reconciliation system while maintaining recovery rate in 80% range.

EPR PRAIRIE PERFORMANCE OIL CONTAINERS



Oil Containers – Program remains our biggest challenge and our major focus.

Containers Recycled *thousands of kilograms*
