Rent Assist can help make your rent affordable

Rent Assist is a housing benefit for lower-income Manitobans who rent apartments and homes in the private market. It can help you lower your out-of-pocket rent payment and give you more flexibility in your monthly budgeting.

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR RENT ASSIST IF YOU:

- Are a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada
- Are 18 years of age or older
- Pay rent for an apartment or home

WHAT TO KNOW:

- You'll need to show proof of your lease or tenancy agreement to apply
- > You'll need to provide your income tax documents to be eligible
- You cannot receive Rent Assist if you are also collecting Employment and Income Assistance (EIA) benefits
- Your benefits will be determined by your income and median market rental rates

The maximum benefits available reflect 80 percent of the median market rent in Winnipeg. Benefit amounts are indexed every year, so if the cost of renting goes up, so do your benefits.
