



# MANITOBA BIODIESEL IN DIESEL MANDATE

*Biodiesel Mandate For Diesel Fuel Regulation M.R. 147/2009, as amended*

The volume of diesel fuel and blended biodiesel fuel sold for use in the areas of Manitoba exempt under subsection 3.1(1) of the *Biodiesel Mandate For Diesel Fuel Regulation* are to be excluded from the calculations in the compliance formula. The exempt areas are areas of Manitoba that are north of latitude 55°N, areas serviced by a winter road and communities serviced by Provincial Roads Nos. 373 and 374.

### Supporting Documentation

The fuel supplier must provide the following supporting documentation:

The volume of diesel fuel and blended biodiesel fuel sold for use in the exempt areas of Manitoba during the interim period.

**Note:**

A fuel supplier is defined as a registered collector under *The Fuel Tax Act* (Manitoba).

Fuel suppliers must report volumes that they sold in Manitoba (placed in the market). Each volume should be reported only once; when it is first sold (placed in the market). Volumes sold in Manitoba include volumes used by a fuel supplier or sold at wholesale or retail in Manitoba. Volumes sold in Manitoba do not include diesel fuel and biodiesel blended fuel sold in exempt areas.

A transaction (under an inter-fuel supplier agreement) between fuel suppliers is not considered a sale.

Biodiesel blends are defined as blends of biodiesel (B100) and diesel fuel.

Biodiesel blends and diesel fuel that are sold for export are not subject to the mandate.

Fuel suppliers that do not sell diesel fuel at wholesale or retail in the Manitoba market are not required to complete this form.

Calculation of the % BIO shall be rounded to the nearest one-hundredth or, where it is equidistant, to the higher one-hundredth.

Interim report must be submitted by March 31, 2012.
