PPE Required: Safety glasses or face shield, hearing protection, steel- toe boots

Warning: Do not wear loose clothing or rolled up sleeves

Remove all jewelry

Steps:

1. Use lockout procedure (See section III-C, G-11) if hard wired.

- 2. Read and understand equipment manual for saw blade changes.
- 3. Remove guards if equipped.
- 4. Remove locking nut and blade. Locking nut may have reverse rotation.
- 5. Install new blade. Note rotation of blade.
- 6. Replace guards.
- 7. Plug in saw and test run. Observe blade rotation and check for any wobble before use.
- 8. Disconnect the saw from its power source.
