## **PPE Required:** Safety glasses or face shield, hearing protection, steel- toe boots

## Warning: Do not wear loose clothing or rolled up sleeves Remove all jewelry

## Steps:

- 1. Read and understand equipment manual before operating.
- 2. Check oil level on air compressor engine. Add oil if necessary.
- 3. Check air filters and clean as required.
- 4. Ensure all air valves are closed.
- 5. Turn start/run lever to start position.
- 6. Prime carburetor by pumping choke control 12-15 times. Leave choke out fully.
- 7. Turn key to engage starter. If engine does not start, turn key to off, prime 2-3 more times, then repeat step 4
- 8. When engine starts, slowly push choke in as engine warms up.
- 9. When engine has warmed up, turn start/run lever to run position.
- 10. Securely attach air hose to air outlet at one end, and blow-pipe at the other. In both cases insert safety locking pin.
- 11. After ensuring that valve at blow-pipe end is in "off position, open valve at compressor.
- 12. Holding blow-pipe securely, slowly open valve at blow pipe.
