## **PPE Required:** Safety glasses or face shield, hearing protection, steel-toe boots

Warning:Do not wear loose clothing or rolled up sleeves<br/>Remove all jewelry<br/>Disconnect the power before repairing or servicing<br/>Ensure cord is not in water and the tool is grounded or double insulated

## Steps:

- 1. Read and understand equipment manual before operating miter saw.
- 2. Guards and guides must be in place and used at all times.
- 3. Inspect saw. Ensure the blade is properly installed and sharp, check wiring for damage.
- 4. Ensure the work area is free of debris and obstructions.
- 5. Plug in and start the saw. Observe for rotation and wobble
- 6. Begin cutting material. Keep both hands firmly on the tool handles and use clamps to secure work.
- 8. Unplug the saw from the power source. Clear the work area of debris.
