**PPE Required:** Safety glasses or face shield, hearing protection, steel-toe boots

**Warning** Do not wear gloves, loose clothing or rolled up sleeves

Remove all jewelry

Disconnect the power before repairing or servicing

## **Steps:**

1. Read and understand equipment manual before operating drill press.

- 2. Guards must be in place and used at all times.
- 3. Secure the material to be drilled securely with a clamp or vise.
- 4. Adjust the speed of the drill as required.
- 5. Be sure to remove the chuck key from the chuck before starting the drill press.
- 6. Make all adjustments with the power off.
- 7. The table or drill stop should be adjusted to prevent drilling through the material and into the table.
- 8. Securely lock the drill bit into the chuck.
- 9. Shut off the power when you have completed drilling and remove the drill bit from the chuck. Clear the table of debris before leaving the machine.
