PPE Required: Steel-toe boots, coveralls, safety glasses, hard hat, gloves

Preparation:

- 1. Two qualified personnel must perform the job (operator and another qualified person).
- 2. Move into shop or on to level ground that will not interfere in other work.
- 3. Set parking brake and block wheels.
- 4. Make sure tools and new cutting blade is on hand.

Steps:

- 1. Lift bucket up so it can be worked on comfortably and use approved safety stands to support bucket.
- 2. Using *Equipment Turn Off Procedure* (section III-E, VLE-4), shut engine off and make sure brake is on and block wheels.
- 3. Clean dirt off blade (pound blade with hammer if required).
- 4. To loosen blade bolts use penetrating oil.
- 5. To loosen all bolts use proper size socket.
- 6. Avoid being under the bucket at any time.
- 7. With help of a partner remove blade using the *Manual Lifting Safe Work Practice* (section III-F, SWP-1).
- 8. With help of your partner put new blade on loosely. Then tighten in place. Use the *Manual Lifting Safe Work Practice* (section III-F, SWP-1).
- 9. Remove all tools, old blade etc. away from tractor.
- 10. Try blade and re-check to make sure bolts have not become loose.
