Refer to part 22 of *The Manitoba Workplace Safety and Health Act and Regulations*, Powered Mobile Equipment.

PPE Required: Safety glasses, hard hat, hearing protection, steel-toe boots and high visibility

safety vest, emergency eye wash bottle

Warning: Check with utilities before any work begins

Inspect the work area to check for hazards

Appropriate operational fire extinguishers must be in tractor Only licensed personnel should operate a tractor on a road. Only competent persons allowed to operate heavy equipment.

Steps:

- 1. Ensure the equipment has a rollover protective structure (ROPS) before operating. ROPS must meet SAE Standard J1042 (2003), Operator Protection for General-Purpose Industrial Machines. Contact the regional office regarding equipment that does not have ROPS or a structure that was not commercially manufactured.
- 2. Mount and dismount using Getting On or Off Equipment Procedure (section III-C, G-1).
- 3. Use Starting Equipment Procedure (section III-E, VLE-5) and warm to operating temperature.
- 4. While warming up, do a circle check of your tractor to ensure there are no leaks, damage or loose bolts etc.. Make sure it is ready for work.
- 5. Check hydraulics to ensure they are working properly.
- 6. Check all gauges, lights and the back-up alarm.
- 7. Check the operation of the bucket, tilting, raising and lowering. Complete pre-use inspection form or log book.
- 8. Proceed to work area, check steering and brakes as you go.
- 9. Maintain proper distances from other working equipment or workers.
- 10. Do not allow anyone near your bucket dumping area.
- 11. Do not allow any person near the place you are working unless absolutely necessary.
- 12. Check the tractor over when you have completed the job.

- 13. Park the tractor in a safe area and lower hydraulic attachments.
- 14. Use the *Equipment Turn Off Procedure* (section III-E, VLE-4).
- 15. Set parking brake.
