PPE Required: Steel-toe boots, safety glasses, coveralls, hard hat, gloves

Preparation:

- 1. Prepare work area.
- 2. Lock out vehicle as per Lockout Procedure (section III-C, G-11).
- 3. Set parking brake and block wheels.
- 4. Gather all necessary equipment and tools.
- 5. Ensure good lighting.

Steps:

- 1. Using a creeper and trouble light, go to each grease nipple and wipe clean with a rag.
- 2. Apply grease to each nipple until grease boot is full or a small amount of grease emerges from joint.
- 3. Replace any damaged nipples as required and check for worn joints.
- 4. Clean grease gun, light and creeper.
- 5. Remove lock out from vehicle.
