Loon Straits is located on the east shore of Lake Winnipeg diagonally opposite Washow Bay and about 50 kilometres (km) north of Manigotagan.

An all season road connects to an access road. Other access is gained by boat and barge from Calder's Dock on the west shore 11 km across the narrow portion of the lake.
