BABS FRIESEN

Eira "Babs" Friesen (1917-2008) was a community activist and long-time YWCA and YMCA-YWCA of Winnipeg volunteer. She was the originator of the Y-Neighbours program, which brought stay-at-home moms and pre-schoolers together for exercise, mutual support and companionship. The program was so successful, it soon spread city-wide and remains so today.

Recognizing another need, she was instrumental in establishing the Women's Resource Centre at the Winnipeg YWCA in 1973. This was the first such centre offering women information, support, and guidance in Western Canada and the model for dozens of social safety net programs and organizations ever since. She was active with her church, immigrant women, MATCH International, the Provincial Council of Women of Manitoba and the Council of Women of Winnipeg, the UN Platform for Action Committee and the University Women's Club.

She received numerous awards and honours for her contributions, including the Queen's Jubilee Award, the Premier's Volunteer Service Award, the Medal of Merit from the Girl Guides of Canada, the Paul LeJeune Volunteer Service Award from the Manitoba Council for International Cooperation, the 50th Anniversary United Nations Global Citizen Award and the YMCA-YWCA Woman of Distinction Award. In 2003, she was inducted into the Order of Canada, and the same year, was the recipient of the Governor General's Award in Commemoration of the Persons Case.

Please respond to each of the questions below. Please use point form and provide specific examples. Do not exceed one 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of paper (minimum 12 point font) per question. Information is provided in italics to help you with answering these questions.

a) How has the nominee contributed as a role model for other women?

- *Demonstrated vision and pioneering spirit in the advancement of women and the quality of women's lives over her lifetime*
- *Enriched, enabled or influenced others by virtue of her involvement*
- *Educated, supported and encouraged female successors, colleagues and peers*
- *Demonstrated admirable qualities such as responsible leadership, perseverance or being a voice for others*

b) What are the nominee's unique and outstanding achievements?

- *Breaking new ground or old barriers*
- *Making a distinct and describable difference*
- *Acting as an advocate or elder supporting women's endeavours*

c) How has the nominee contributed to gender equality?

- *Improved the economic, social, legal and health status of women*
- *Is an agent for change either within her particular community or the world at large*

3 | LETTERS OF SUPPORT

Please provide a minimum of two letters of support, which add specific information not otherwise contained in the nomination form. Photos, tapes, video and resumes will not be accepted. Letters of support should not come from the Nominator.

4 | RESUME (MAXIMUM 3 PAGES)

Please attach a resume or equivalent which outlines the nominee's background, career and present work or activity including: organizational involvement, volunteer activities, education, awards, recognitions and other achievements.



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SELECTION PROCESS

Nominations will be evaluated only on the merit of the submissions received. As a nominator, it is your responsibility to reflect the achievements of the nominee to the selection committee, to draw out their exceptional nature. Be thorough and factual. The nomination package of each nominee will be reviewed for clarification. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

The decisions of the Selection Committee are confidential and will be announced prior to the Women of Distinction Awards Dinner on Wednesday May 4, 2011.
