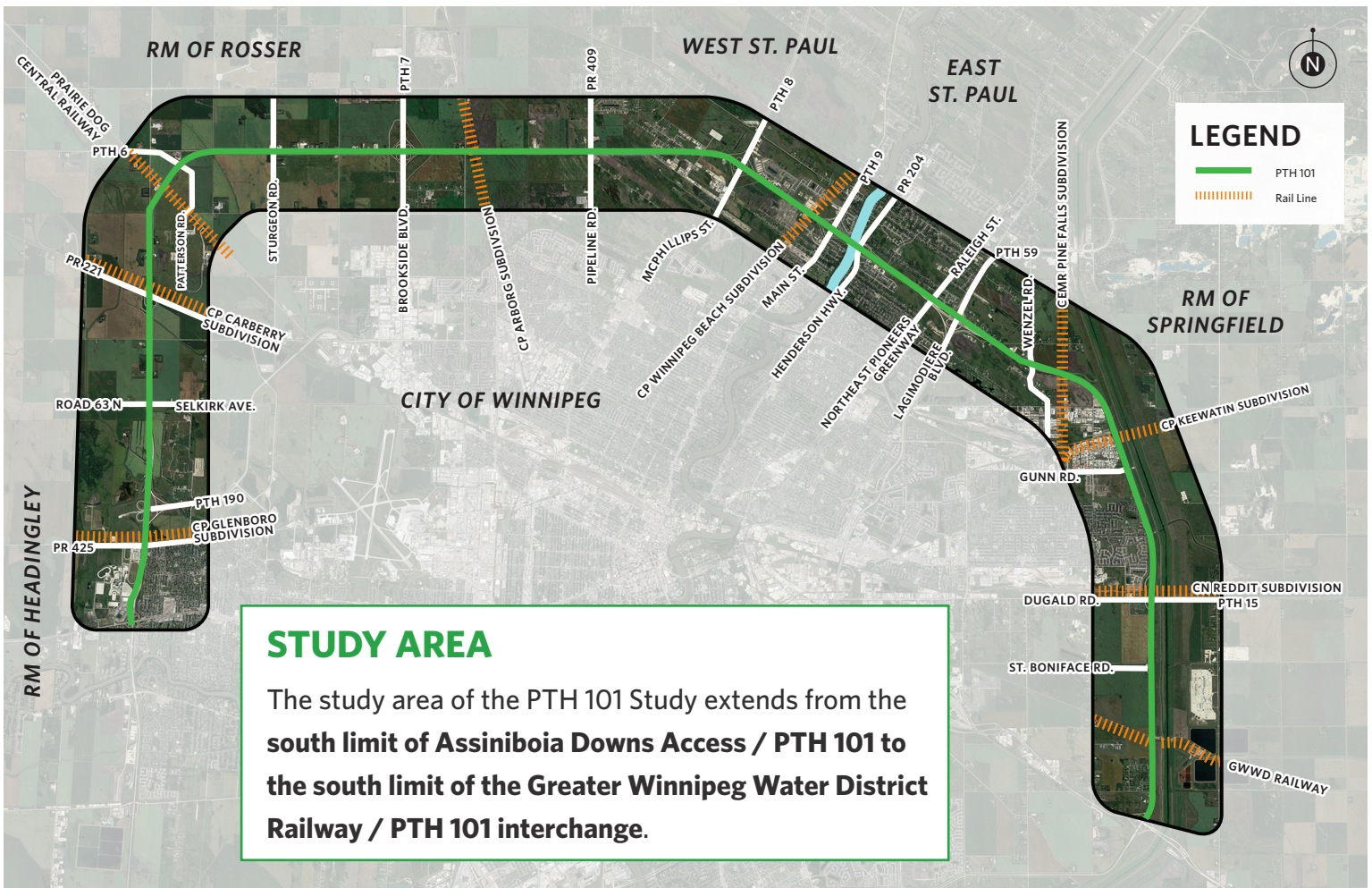
North Perimeter (PTH 101) Highway Design Study

INTRODUCTION

The Manitoba government has initiated a study to develop a functional design for PTH 101 (the North Perimeter Highway).

STUDY DESCRIPTION

The goal of the study is to develop a preferred functional design for reconstructing PTH 101 to a freeway standard, and conceptual designs of its associated structures. These may include proposed interchanges, rail grade separations and waterways crossings.
