



In addition to the enclosed Environment Act Licence requirements, please be informed that all other applicable federal, provincial and municipal regulations and by-laws must be complied with. In particular, I would bring to your attention that the Manitoba Department of Culture, Heritage and Citizenship, Historic Resources Branch has requested that you advise them of the location of the gravel source which is to provide the material to be placed on the reef. The Historic Resources Branch would like the opportunity to assess and, if necessary, examine the location of the gravel source prior to extraction for the presence of archeological materials.
