for the construction and maintenance of the Development being stream channel changes for the purposes of flood control and drainage in Sections 20 and 29, Township 23, Range 14 WPM and subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1) The Licencee shall contruct the Development in accordance with methods outlined in the Environment Act Proposal dated April 20,1992 and the additional information dated July 30, 1992, both submitted to Manitoba Environment by A. Ewashko Consulting.
- 2) The Licencee shall replant disturbed areas of natural vegetation with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or with trees.
- 3) The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development shall be collected and disposed of in accordance with Manitoba Environment requirements.
- 4) The Licencee shall arrange, prior to beginning construction, to have Manitoba Fisheries Branch staff identify suitable areas for the preservation of natural areas and the construction of meanders, pools and riffles.

Revocation

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding any of the specifications, limits, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
