THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

Canadian Pacific Railway: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a river bank stabilization project on the banks of the Morris River located in NE 3-5-1E subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:


Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated October 16, 1992, the supplementary report "Hydraulic Design and Impacts of the Stabilization Berm at CP Rail Bridge at Morris", dated December, 1992, and supplementary material dated February 18, 1993, all submitted by KGS Group on behalf of the Licencee.
2. The Licencee shall construct the riverbank stabilization berm downstream of the CP Rail bridge in accordance with KGS drawing number 92-033-0302.
3. The Licencee shall, prior to beginning construction activities on the riverbank stabilization berm upstream of the CP Rail bridge, submit, for the approval of the Director, detailed plans for the construction of that portion of the Development.
4. The Licencee shall reseed exposed soil with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
5. The Licencee shall, by October 1, 1993, submit to the Director copies of agreements with affected landowners respecting compensation for flooding damages to the property affected by the portion of the Development downstream of the CP Rail Bridge.
6. The Licencee shall, prior to beginning construction activities on the portion of the Development upstream of the CP Rail bridge, submit to the Director, copies of agreements with any affected landowners respecting compensation for flooding damages to the property affected by that portion of the Development.
7. The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
8. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
