

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and GARRY H. HOUSTON, Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Garry H. Houston submitted an application to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a pet kennel registered as Gleneagle Kennels located at the intersection of Symington and Dawson Roads in the Rural Municipality of Springfield, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission issued Order No. 352 on the 27th day of May, 1975, prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Applicant submitted to the said Commission on the 22nd day of August, 1975, a request for the variation of Order No. 352 to increase the limit on the number of dogs from 68 to 168;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission held a public hearing in Winnipeg, Manitoba on the 20th day of October, 1975, to hear evidence and representations in connection with the said request for variation;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the said request for variation on the 10th day of November, 1975;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT ORDER NUMBER 352
BE VARIED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Applicant shall ensure that the total number of dogs is limited to 168 on the premises of the said operation at any one time.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that all wastes of the said operation, other than dead animals, are:
 - (a) conveyed to a municipal waste disposal ground, with the prior approval of the Municipality, or
 - (b) buried on the site and finally covered with a minimum of 12" of compacted earth.

3. The Applicant shall ensure that all dead animals are:
 - (a) removed for final disposal by the owner;
 - (b) buried with at least two feet of earthen cover in a plot set aside for this purpose on the property of the applicant; or
 - (c) incinerated in an incinerator adequate for this purpose.


4. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of housekeeping and maintenance is carried on commensurate with:
 - (a) preventing the occurrence of any unsightly or malodorous situation; and,
 - (b) ensuring that there is no deposit, discharge or emission of contaminants off the premises into the environment by reason of the said operation.
