

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and ANCHOR INDUSTRIES LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Anchor Industries Ltd., filed an application with the Department of Mines, Natural Resources and Environment in connection with the operation of a leisure boat manufacturing plant emitting odours and particulate matter to the atmosphere, the said plant being located at 718-1st Street in the City of Brandon, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the Commission by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits on the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the said application on the 18th day of June, 1979;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that, on and after the 1st day of April, 1980, particulate matter from the various processes of the said operation do not exceed 0.57 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury at the point of emission.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that, on and after the 1st day of April, 1980, the odour emanating from the said operation is not detectable at any point of impingement past the property line of the said operation when one volume of odourous air is diluted with one volume of odour-free air.

3. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times consistent with meeting the limits prescribed in Clauses 1 and 2 of this Order.
