

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and STAN-RO-ENTERPRISES LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Stan-Ro-Enterprises Ltd., filed a proposal with the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs and Environment in connection with the operation of a plant for the manufacture of bathroom fixtures from fiberglass-reinforced plastic, the said plant to be located at or near 536 Dobbie Avenue, in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS no representations were made to the Commission by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the proposal on the 21st day of July, 1980;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall not permit the emission of particulate matter from any process of the said operation to exceed a concentration of 0.2 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury at the point of emission.
2. The Applicant shall limit the emission of odours to such an extent that the odours emanating from the said operation are not detectable at any point of impingement beyond the property line of the operation and
  - (a) in a residential area or an area zoned residential when one volume of odourous air is diluted with one equal volume of odour-free air;
  - (b) in an industrial area or an area zoned industrial when one volume of odourous air is diluted with six equal volumes of odour-free air.
