AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and MONARCH INDUSTRIES LIMITED,
Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Monarch Industries Limited, Leocraft Division, filed an application with the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs and Environment in connection with the operation of a plant for the manufacture of items including boats and septic tanks from fibreglass-reinforced plastic, the said plant being located at or near 20 Burnett Avenue in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS after giving notice of the application, the Commission did not receive a representation from any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 18th day of August, 1980;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall not permit the emission of solid particulate matter from any process of the said operation to exceed a concentration of 0.57 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury.
2. The Applicant shall limit the emission of odour from the said operation to such an extent that the said odour, when sampled at any point of impingement beyond the property line of the operation and in a residential area, is not detectable when one volume of odourous air is diluted with one volume of odour-free air.
