The Municipality of WestLake-Gladstone has approval under License No. 3203 for the removal of biosolids at the Gladstone lagoon located on 24-14-11W and had been working with Darrin Keam at WSP to obtain this license. Together we had reviewed a number of options and continue to work toward the successful completion of this project.

The Municipality has applied for funding under various streams but has been unsuccessful to date. As this project has been identified as part of our five-year capital plan, our council would like to complete as much biosolid removal as possible this season.

I am requesting an extension to our license until 2025 in order to ensure that we can feasibly accomplish this very important project. We may not be able to complete all biosolid removal this season, but intend to remove as much of the 7,000 CuM3 from cell 1 as our budget allows. We will continue in that manner until all 3 cells have been cleaned.

We gratefully appreciate the consideration and understanding in this matter and look forward to proceeding with this renewal.
