## Re: Canexus Corporation – Licence No. 2619 RRRR – Notice of Alteration

Receipt of the June 23, 2016 letter and report prepared by Dillon Consulting Ltd. on behalf of Canexus Corporation (Canexus) is acknowledged as a notice of alteration in accordance with section 14 of *The Environment Act*.

The requested change to the Development as Licensed is for the continued operation of a 115 kilovolt transformer that was previously installed by Canexus in 2014. The new transformer was installed to increase reliability and reduce stress on another transformer at the Development which was operating at maximum capacity.

The potential environmental effect of the requested change to the development as Licensed is insignificant and considered to be a minor alteration in accordance with section 14(2) of *The Environment Act*. Approval is hereby granted for the operation of the transformer as described in the June 23, 2016 letter and report and conditional upon the acceptance of a revised Environment Act Licence to be issued at a later date.

The notice of alteration also requested that the Licencee name be changed to Canexus Corporation. The legal name of the Licencee has been updated in our records and will be reflected in the revised Environment Act Licence.
