**Re: Mountain Quota Holders Association - Environment Act Licence No. 2601**

I am responding to your letter of May 30, 2014, requesting approval for a two year extension of Environment Act Licence No. 2601 to allow the Mountain Quota Holders Association (MQHA) to continue forestry operations in Forest Management Units (FMUs) 12 and 14.

I am accepting your letter as a notice of alteration, consisting of a two year extension of your current licence. It has been determined that the potential environmental effects of the licence extension are insignificant and can be accommodated by the existing limits, terms and conditions of Environment Act Licence No. 2601.

In accordance with Section 14(2) of The Environment Act, I am hereby extending the expiration date of Environment Act Licence No. 2601 to May 31, 2016, subject to the following conditions:

1. A valid Annual Operating Plan must be maintained for FMUs 12 and 14;
2. All specifications, limits, terms and conditions identified in Environment Act Licence No. 2601 shall be strictly adhered to; and
3. Any additional specifications, limits, terms and conditions that may be identified by the Director of Forestry Branch and the Regional Integrated Resource Management Team of Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship shall be strictly adhered to.
