## Re: Plasti-Fab Ltd. – Environment Act Proposal

The Environment Act Proposal (EAP) you submitted on September 12, 2013 for the Expandable Polystyrene (EPS) foam manufacturing plant located at 2485 Day Street, Winnipeg, MB has been reviewed. The following additional information is required before we proceed with processing the EAP:

- 1. Complete description of the facility such as production capacity, plant floor plan, equipment arrangements, etc.
- 2. Detailed process description quantifying VOC emission during each stage of the EPS foam manufacturing. The information provided in Appendix G is not complete as it considers only emission from the foam block cutting area.
- 3. Method of Luconyl dye application to the foam including any potential emission.
- 4. Any available VOC and other emission capture or control technology installed in the facility. Consider both point and fugitive emission sources.
- 5. The quantity of each chemical used per day or per week and the quality of each of them stored onsite at a given time.
