This memo is in response to the letter dated July 24, 2014 from Tracey Braun. In order to comply with the requirements of the CCME 1997 guideline a significant capital investment would be required. Currently (YTD 2014) we have used 55% of our resin feedstock containing <5% pentane and the remaining feedstock contained 6.8% pentane.

Plasti-Fab plans to continue transitioning foam products over to the low (<5%) pentane resin over the next 1 to 2 years until we are using only low pentane resin. A complete transition is not possible at this time due to the financial burden of a large capital project. This type of investment would put us at a significant competitive disadvantage in the current economic market.
