This bursary is managed by the MANITOBA WALL & CEILING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND and THE WINNIPEG FOUNDATION.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Demonstrated financial need
- Ability to succeed
- Excellent written letter of reference
- Registration with Apprenticeship Manitoba

VALUE OF AWARDS

The amount of each bursary is influenced by the number of eligible applicants received and the amount of annual earnings of the MANITOBA WALL & CEILING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND.

Applications will be reviewed by the MANITOBA WALL & CEILING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND committee and selections will be made by May 31.

Only the successful recipient(s) will be notified by mail in June of their award. A cheque from THE WINNIPEG FOUNDATION will follow, if apprenticeship registration has been confirmed or once apprenticeship registration is confirmed.

Deferrals requests must be received in writing by THE WINNIPEG FOUNDATION by JUNE 30 and validated within one year of receiving notice of reward.

In the event a prospective apprentice does not register with Apprenticeship Manitoba during the period outlined above, the bursary amount will remain in the MANITOBA WALL & CEILING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND.

Should a recipient, for any reason withdraw from the apprenticeship program, the total amount of the bursary shall become due immediately and repayable to MANITOBA WALL & CEILING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND. The MANITOBA WALL & CEILING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND committee may consider appeals in exceptional circumstances.
