Apprenticeship Manitoba

As of January 2023 Apprenticeship Manitoba will no longer be generating the paper report of hours (blue book) document. All apprentice hours will be reported online using Access Manitoba. (www.accessmanitoba.ca/).

This means that over the next 12 months Apprenticeship Manitoba will be working with employers to ensure they are prepared to report hours online.

Some things employers need to think about are:

- 1. Which of my staff need access to the business account to report hours?
- 2. Do those staff have an individual profile in Access Manitoba?
- 3. Have these staff reported hours on line in the past? Do they require training?
