Out of Order

A motion is "out of order" when it is moved while a motion of higher precedence is pending.

A person is "out of order" when speaking without recognition of the chairperson

or

when a person who is not a member in good standing of the organization speaks.

Note: some organizations allow input from everyone in attendance; only those with voting power are able to vote.

A remark is "out of order" when it violates a ruling of the organization.
