# Farm Income 2022



### Manitoba Farm Income 2022


- Farm cash receipts for 2022 were \$9.75 billion, up 14.8 per cent or \$1.26 billion from 2021. Crop and livestock receipts established new records at \$6.09 billion and \$3.02 billion, respectively, while program payments were \$634 million.
- Crop receipts at \$6.09 billion were up 15.0 per cent from \$5.30 billion in 2021. Canola generated \$2.37 billion in sales, up 17.1 per cent from 2021 while wheat sales increased by 15.0 per cent to \$1.68 billion in 2022. Soybean receipts jumped 54.6 per cent to \$716 million in 2022. Potatoes, oats and grain corn each set new records as well at \$357 million (up 16.9 per cent), \$328 million (up 46.7 per cent) and \$288 million (up 59.2 per cent), respectively.
- Livestock receipts grew 8.8 per cent to \$3.02 billion in 2022 from \$2.78 billion in 2021. Hog receipts increased 7.1 per cent to \$1.51 billion for 2022 from \$1.41 billion in 2021. Cattle and calf receipts climbed 9.6 per cent to \$688 million. Farm cash receipts for milk rose 8.5 per cent to \$354 million, while chickens for meat gained 14.2 per cent to \$162 million and egg receipts increased 20.4 per cent to \$157 million.
- Program payments increased 51.8 per cent to \$634 million in 2022 from \$418 million in 2021.
- For 2022, operating expenses jumped 21.5 per cent to \$7.22 billion, with large increases across the board including 56.1 per cent in fertilizer, 23.1 per cent in commercial feed, 59.9 per cent in machinery fuel, 24.5 per cent in interest expenses and a 31.0 per cent rise in crop and hail insurance premiums.
- Net cash incomes (farm cash receipts less operating expenses) declined 0.9 per cent to \$2.52 billion in 2022.
- Realized net income (farm cash receipts less operating and depreciation expenses) dropped 5.1 per cent to \$1.60 billion in 2022.
- Total net income jumped by \$2.01 billion to \$2.81 billion in 2022 from \$806 million in 2021 as a result of the large replenishment of crop inventories with the 2022 harvest following the drawdown that occurred in 2021 as a consequence of the drought in that year.


### PROVINCES (CURRENT DOLLARS) FARM CASH RECEIPTS, 2021-2022




### MANITOBA (NOMINAL DOLLARS) FARM INCOME AND EXPENSES, 51-YEAR TREND, 1971 - 2022
