SECURITY REQUIREMENTS

An applicant for a livestock dealer's licence shall provide the Minister with the following security levels in the form of a security bond issued by a surety company licensed to transact business in Manitoba; or an irrevocable letter of credit (L.O.C.) from a chartered bank, credit union or trust company. Or the security can be provided by a combination of both an L.O.C. and a security bond.

The amount of security required shall be determined on the basis of the number of livestock purchased in the previous year according to the following table:
