Mandate:

Responsibilities:

The board manages and conducts the business and affairs of the college; and exercises the rights, powers and privileges of the college in the name and on behalf of the college.

Education Approval Committee

The committee reviews and makes recommendations to the Board on the establishment and maintenance of Standards for Psychiatric Nursing Education. The Committee supervises the Approval Process that is done by an external evaluator and makes recommendations to the Board of Directors on the basis of the evaluator's report.

Membership:

12 Members (1/3 Public Representatives – 50% appointed by the Minister)
Public Representatives are appointed by the Minister.

Education Approval Committee

6 Members (1/3 Public Representatives – 50% appointed by the Minister)
Public Representatives Appointed by the Minister.

Length of Terms:

Board:

2 Year Term (10 Year Recommendation)

Education Approval Committee:

2 Year Term, 3 Term Max (10 Year Recommendation)

Desirable Expertise:

- A person who is not and never has been registered under this Act and who is not a member of a health profession regulated by an Act of the Legislature for which the minister has statutory responsibility;
- A person who is interested in health and is well informed on health matters generally. An interest in mental health, in particular, would be an asset;
- A person who is interested in the regulation of health professions;
- Previous committee or board experience would be an asset.
